 Submitted Voting Items: Vote to approve: Funding for 3D Printers for the creation of a 3D Printing/Manufacturing Lab Budget: up to \$27,000 maximum This proposal includes up to ten 3D printers of various sizes, along with filament and extruders. Vendor has added two free printers (new add-on since first quote was received.) 	 Discussion: New curriculum has been approved by the College Curriculum Committee and forwarded to the state. It is the intention of the CTE department to start offering classes/certificates in fall 2017. The curriculum will include noncredit certificates of completion and pathways to credit bearing programs. \$46.90 per hour (incl. benefits per the CEFA salary) x 149 hours 	 Discussion: Students will be able to earn a noncredit certificate for court reporting. This certificate will be able to be earned within one-year. The credit and noncredit departments at SCC are working together to create a pathway which will lead to a higher-level certificate and/or degree.
